Copy/Holding information

You will be asked to enter your borrower ID and PIN to log in.

**Middlesex students:** enter your student number as ID and date of birth (DDMMYY) as PIN.

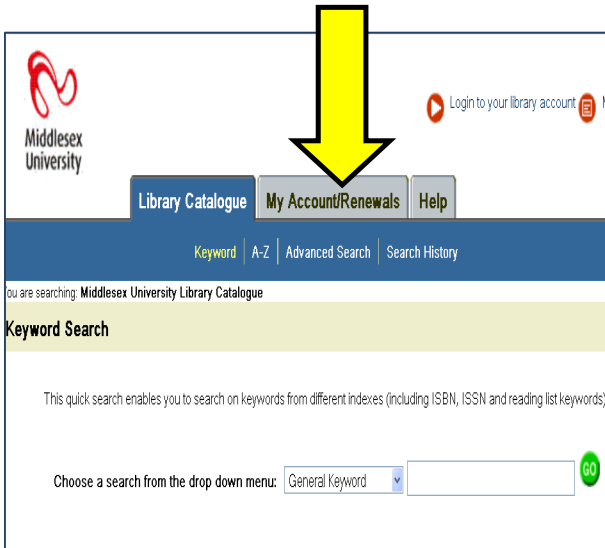
**UCL students and NHS staff:** enter the number above the barcode (beginning with P for NHS staff) on the back of your library card as ID and 111111 as PIN.

The *Request Confirmation* screen will now be displayed. Select your pick-up location by clicking on the down arrow and highlighting one of the options (UCL students should only opt for Archway Healthcare Library).

Click on the *Request* button to confirm your request. You can then either log out or continue searching.

## Renewing an item

From the library catalogue home page click on the *My Account/Renewals* tab at the top of the screen:



Log in and click on *Items Out*. This will list the items you have on loan and due dates.

Items may be renewed as long as no one has requested them and you do not have fines of over £10 owing.

To renew an item check the box to the left of each title then click *Renew* at the top of the list. Check the new due date.

A message will appear above any item where the renewal has failed. Contact the library and be prepared to return it as a renewal may not be possible.
